### SOLAR AND SANITATION PROJECTS UNDER WAY FOR THE CHRISTAID ACADEMY



In June of 2013, Barry Charelle joined a mission trip team to help build the first Grandma house in Kucina. As he worked on block production, he used the deplorable "outhouse facilities" that the kids at the school were forced to use. He declared that he would come home and raise the money to put in flush toilets for the kids! Not only did he do that, with God's help he raised enough to put solar collectors on the roofs of each classroom to power solar lights and the computers which had been donated long before. WAY TO THINK BIG, BARRY!!

To the Glory of God, , his dream turned into reality on this trip. Shown here the team is digging a trench to pipe water from the spring below to hand-dug holes for the holding tanks to allow for flushing. The "boys" bathrooms were completed first and the first flush was a thing of beauty!! Below...both eyes and cameras are trained on the first solar light to come on in the school. 
