This summer's trip was incredible - Wow! What an amazing team of co-laborers from Holy Shepherd Lutheran Church in Lakewood. I was blown away with their unending faith-

fulness and willingness to serve.

The container that we sent back in February arrived in time for us to distribute the majority of it's contents. The backpacks and school bags were a Huge blessing to hundreds of local schoolchildren. All of our Ahadi kids and grandmas received one. It was heartwarming to see

the towns and villages swarming with kids and their packs. We distributed books and Bibles to a local prison library, and set up a computer lab at ChristAid Primary School with the donated computer equipment.

God brought such a great variety of talents in the individuals on

our team. They served in prison outreach, arranged a luncheon and nutrition seminar for our Grandmas, organized a ChristAid Primary School craft and field day, got dirty doing painting projects, made home visits, lead a pastor's seminar on servant leadership, put on an AIDS prevention lecture at Mountains of the Moon University, the list goes on! We now even have an official science lab with microscopes and other supplies at our school, which is really unheard of for a Primary School - especially in such a rural area.

God always has a way of orchestrating things in His perfect timing, and one of the beautiful stories that transpired on this trip was about a little girl named Margaret.

Her mother and grandmother had died a while back leaving her with an elderly grandfather and a difficult and abusive father when she was about eight years old.

Margaret was so bright that even at such a young age, she was chosen to be the official interpreter at our Primary

School when English speaking guests would visit.

She was desperately poor though and among other awful

things, she would get kicked out of the house on occasion by her father in one of his rages and forced to sleep outside amidst the mosquitoes, predators and thieves.

I met her about a year prior, and prayed and prayed for her! God brought her a sponsor on this team. Her life changed drastically within 48 hours. What an answer to prayer!

Our team visited Margaret's dysfunctional home on a Saturday. With all the blessings received, her father ended up coming to church the next day and repented in front of the congregation. Margaret moved into a safer environment - a good boarding school.

There she was reunited with another lovely orphan girl (older than she) who was originally from Margaret's same village. Her friend immediately welcomed Margaret and made her feel comfortable at her new school.

She does not have to sleep outside any more, and she can now get a good education and have time to study.

This is just another miracle story of what our Ahadi Kids program can accomplish by God's grace, and how God uses us here, 8,000 miles away to make an enormous difference in one person's life.


