Excellent progress is being made on our ChristAid office building, which is being built to give us self-sustainability! Our own office staff will be moving in as soon as the terrazzo floors are complete. (The "dust is flying" as we speak as the floor material is ground down and polished.)

### THOUGHTS FROM PASTOR BRUCE –ON THE PASSING OF OUR CHRISTAID FOUNDER, DAVID MPORAMPORA

The sudden and unexpected death of David Mporampora has shocked and saddened all who knew him here in the U.S. and in Uganda. Few people will make the same impact on as many lives as David; however, ChristAid International, the ministry he founded and worked diligently to build, continues as a tribute to his faith and vision.



David's funeral service was held in Fort Portal, Uganda on January 2, 2020 and was attended by thousands of people. Numerous people spoke including government officials, the Bishop of the Episcopal Church in Fort Portal, students from the ChristAid Academy, and the current ChristAid Director, Grace Mugasa. All were thankful for the work that David did to improve the lives of the people of Kicuna and Fort Portal area.

Although the greatest tribute to David is ChristAid itself, which continues to flourish under the excellent leadership of Grace, there are other memorials which ensure that he is not forgotten. The first two were in place already before David's death. First, a plaque displaying a teacher, a student and an elderly Grandma was presented to David at the time of his retirement in 2017. The plaque stands at the entrance to the ChristAid Academy and commemorates the school, the Ahadi Kids program and the Grandmas for Jesus sponsorship programs.

The second was completed and given to David just before his death. A bench and plaque were placed by ChristAid on David's property at the place below the tree where the first classes of ChristAid Academy were held. The plaque reads, "Honoring ChristAid's Founder, David Mporampora, serving from 1995-2017. Philippians 1:6 – He who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion..."

In addition to those, the District 5 Councilman announced that a road will be named "Mporampora Road" in his honor. That has been officially done and a signpost has been set marking the road that leads to ChristAid Academy.

All who spoke at David's funeral expressed appreciation for the great work that David had done to provide education for children, to provide support and housing for elderly Grandmas in the community, and to promote the numerous other projects that ChristAid has instituted to help the people of Fort Portal and the Kicuna region.

They also thanked our current Director, Grace, for the work that she is doing as well as all from the U.S. who make the ministry possible through donations. Finally, there were requests from local government that ChristAid continue to provide support for the area and to expand its ministries where possible. This is a testament to the excellent job Grace is doing to continue the work that has been begun with ChristAid.

A memorial service for David is being planned here in the U.S. by his three children who reside in Denver, the ChristAid staff and others in the community who knew and loved David. Although a date has not yet been set, it is expected to be in late February or March. We will make every attempt to share the details of the service with our "ChristAid community" when they become available.









Since sponsorship of kids into school is the original heartbeat of ChristAid, here we highlight a five-year-old child who is desperate for assistance to attend school. Linnet has already endured some tough breaks in her short life. Her mother has been in a serious accident, is in constant pain and is disabled. Her father has abandoned her altogether.

A friend paid Linnet's original tuition for our Preschool Program, but the friend is no longer able to help. We have been seeking a new sponsor for Linnet since March 2019.

Linnet's job in the family is to fetch water, which often times in the village is a great distance from the home. If you are willing and able to help this child for \$40 a month, to receive life changing education, please contact the ChristAid offices.

#### PROGRESS ON CHRISTAID SECONDARY SCHOOL

Detailed building plans and operating budgets for the ChristAid Secondary School are being finalized with construction to begin in February 2020. Pictured below is the formal "laying of the cornerstone" celebration to mark the construction site, attended by executives of the international ministry, Cunina, who is partnering with us to fund the physical school buildings. Although many of the students will be able to live at home in the nearby villages to attend this school, there will also be a limited amount of dormitory space built for students from other districts. ChristAid will be responsible for maintaining the buildings, running the school and ensuring a profitable business plan to operate the school effectively in the years to come. ChristAid already owns the property on which the buildings are being constructed, which is within sight of the ChristAid Academy (primary school). This will provide a smooth transition for our primary students to continue their Christian education.

Once the buildings have been completed, ChristAid would love to have assistance from our donors to purchase the supplies and other start-up costs of the school. This would include such things as desks, chairs, teaching materials, bed frames and kitchen equipment. There is great excitement among area students for this incredible blessing of having a secondary school in this remote corner of the world!! ## THE VERY BEST OF NEWS FROM CHRISTAID ACADEMY ON THE SUCCESS OF THIS YEAR'S PRIMARY SCHOOL GRADUATES AS THEY TAKE THEIR 7<sup>TH</sup> GRADE "LEAVING EXAMS" for proficiency in science, reading, math, English and Christian education !!!

Once again the results are in for our Primary 7 students taking the annual proficiency test. Our kids do amazingly well, ranked against all other schools in Uganda. Of our 51 students...50 received rankings at the highest level and one ranked at the second level. There are FOUR LEVELS!! (None of our kids were in the third or fourth level!). This makes us the 34<sup>th</sup> BEST SCHOOL IN THE REPUBLIC OF UGANDA! PRETTY COOL!! Enjoy these words paraphrased from the Facebook page of our Head Master, Richard, about the results:
