

### CHRISTAID ... MOVING UP TO THE NEXT LEVEL !!

# What does the "Next Level" look like? Executive Director, Pastor Bruce Van Dusseldorp shares these words about what he is observing......

2017 and 2018 have been overflowing with activity for ChristAid!! It began with the installation of solar power and sanitary restrooms at ChristAid Academy. It included the retirement celebration of our long-time leader of ChristAid, David Mporampora.



This was followed by the commissioning of the new Uganda Director, Grace Mugasa, who speaks frequently about moving us "to the Next Level". **Grace is showing us what that means to her**. She has implemented financial accountability and policy changes which have greatly improved the efficiency of ChristAid. Her staff has responded with appreciation to those efforts and they compliment Grace profusely on her "grace", leadership and wisdom.

"The Next Level" is seen even more <u>concretely</u> (pun intended) in construction projects that are presently in various stages of implementation such as the Preschool now going up, a ChristAid office building being planned and on the horizon.....a ChristAid Secondary School!! (Watch for details here and in the following pages.)

For years, the Board has discussed the need to find ways to facilitate ChristAid Uganda being more self-sustaining. The ministry cannot rely solely on funds from the US, but must have ways in which funds can be generated in Uganda. Thanks to the hard work of ChristAid supporters, that is becoming a possibility!!

Plans are being drawn up for a three story building on land we recently purchased within the town of Fort Portal. When completed the office building will house the CA offices, saving us our monthly lease payments.



Most importantly, it will <u>ALSO</u> provide rental space for other businesses, a large meeting hall, 12 apartments, and possibly a restaurant—all of which will generate income for the ministry of Christaid!!! A large team of friends and family are currently fund raising for this building and are planning a mission trip in January of 2019 to help construct it.

This will truly take ChristAid "<u>to the Next Level</u>" and will help us with funds to support our other branches of our ministry in Kicuna.

As shown above, there is "cool" progress on the ChristAid Preschool building, shown here with the foundation preparations underway. At the back of the second picture, notice the close proximity of the existing ChristAid Academy Primary School building as it steps on down the mountainside. The ChristAid community in Uganda is so excited to have the preschool opportunity available, that they have already started preschool classes in a temporary structure nearby!

The same dedicated teacher (Rose) who taught the first three ChristAid sponsored kids ever (in 1995) under a tree on what would become the current school campus, is the new Director of the Preschool. There are adorable preschool kids now available for sponsorship, some shown below dressed in the new uniforms that were designed for the kids by ChristAid Director, Grace. (Does this feel like we might be going to "the Next Level??)

If your heart leads you to help one of these impoverished children get a running start in life, with the gift of life-changing education, the sponsorship is the same cost (\$40 per month) as for the Primary school children. #### Big Dreams coming true......Ministry support from "Cunina" for a ChristAid Secondary School

For years, ChristAid has had a ministry partner from Belgium called Cunina. Cunina is a non-profit organization that supports education in several developing countries around the world. Our ChristAid Academy (primary school) is one of two schools in all of Uganda that Cunina chooses to support. They began several years ago by sponsoring 20 of our children. Today they sponsor more than 100 at ChristAid Academy. Cunina is very impressed with Grace as our new Director, and we have been greatly blessed by their partnership with us.

We are presently in conversation with Cunina about the possibility of building a secondary school. They approached us with the idea several months ago, and three Board members met with them in Uganda in March to learn more. The costs and details of operation are being firmed up and we are very optimistic about this possibility as we move forward with the due diligence required for such a project. This project, also, moves ChristAid to "the Next Level"!

We thank God and His Grace (pun intended again) for His blessings poured out on us during this last year.
