


CHRISTAID HAS A BRAND NEW LOOK IN 2017

With David's retirement in March of 2017, many things change...not just for David, but for the ministry of ChristAid. While David did fundraising for himself in the 13 years he lived in the US which has continued and sustained him for all these years, the new Director (Grace) does not have that opportunity. Her full time salary must be raised by ChristAid on a monthly basis beginning in February.

Meeting this brand new expense is now a top priority for us. The very best way you could help is to pledge a monthly gift in any amount to be designated for "administration". This would give us some comfort that we have regular gifts coming in (like monthly tuition payments for our Ahadi kids) that we can depend on to help with this critical new expenditure. Please consider helping with this salary expense on a monthly basis.

We would also greatly appreciate any lump sum year-end gifts that people may want to give for this purpose. ChristAid is a 501c3 corporation and sends the tax deduction statements at the end of each year.



The other big change is the hiring of Pastor Bruce Van Dusseldorp, (our current CA President) as the part-time Executive Director of ChristAid on the US side. The time commitment to keep ChristAid business running smoothly has gone far beyond what the volunteer Board of Directors can effectively manage. In one of His signature moves, God has timed Bruce's retirement from serving his church for 26 years at just the time ChristAid desperately needs his attention.
