God is so amazing! After trying every possible means to provide fresh and well treated water to our kids and grandmas in Kicuna, and neighboring villages, we now have the equivalent of city water here in America. The community dug trenches and buried pipes of up to three miles night and day using hoes and shovels. Our old and expensive to maintain water system of pumping water from the river has been upgraded to one of the most beautiful things. Hallelujah!

Grandmas

Our grandma outreach program is doing wonders in the lives of women who are mostly 70 years old and above. Please remember that these old women are actually grandmas to many kids whose parents died mostly of HIV. They face the responsibility of being grandmas, moms, and dads to as many as twenty children.
